DATES OF PLAY: April 23, 24, 25, 2010

START TIME: Friday, April 23rd: Singles registration opens at 4:30 PM and play begins at 5:00 PM
Saturday, April 24th: Doubles registration opens at 8:00 AM and play begins at 9:00 AM
Sunday, April 25th: Mixed Doubles registration opens at 8:00 AM and play begins at 9:00 AM

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received or postmarked by March 31, 2010 (Limited to 100 entries)

ENTRY FEES: Entry fee is \$25 for the first event. \$5 for each additional event

EVENT LOCATION: Duanesburg Area Community Center, indoor gym facility

AGE BRACKETS: All singles and doubles events will be divided into age brackets based on players age as of 12/31/10. Brackets will be determined after all registrations are received.

REGISTRATION

Check-In: You must check in each day that you are playing. Registration opens at 4:30 PM on Friday and at 8:00 AM on Saturday & Sunday.

Cancellation: There will be no refunds unless an event is cancelled and not rescheduled.

FORMAT OF PLAY

Events will be played in accordance with USAPA rules & regulations in effect at the time of the tournament. We will only allow equipment approved by the USAPA.

Double elimination: Win 1 game of 15 points to advance in the winner's bracket. Win 1 game of 15 points to advance in the loser's bracket. All games must be won by 2 points.

The winner of the loser's bracket will play the winner of the top bracket. If the winner of the loser's bracket wins, a tie breaker must be played.

NOTE: Modification of tournament play may be necessary due to time constraints. These changes will be made at the sole discretion of the tournament committee.
